

2022 STN FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Thursday Morning, February 17th 7:45am and 8:30am -Everyone will bring their luggage to Carlsbad High School. One suitcase per person, backpack is also allowed along with any equipment you may need to bring.

Thursday Afternoon, February 17th 12:45pm -Everyone will meet at Carlsbad High School to board the bus. All students and chaperones are responsible for getting themselves to Carlsbad High School. The bus will depart at 1:15pm!

GENERAL CONTEST RULES & REGULATIONS

Student Television Network provides many opportunities throughout the school year for middle school and high school students to compete in head-to-head competition. Awards are presented in recognition of excellence and honors the skills and talents of broadcasting and film students from across the nation. STN contests include, but are not limited to, on-site convention competitions, convention carry-in submissions, and national upload contests. The general rules and regulations for submission of entries to all STN contests are outlined in this document.

Entries that do not follow the Rules & Regulations are subject to penalty by the STN-appointed judges. All decisions by the judges are final. The Board of Directors of Student Television Network reserves the right to change or amend these rules and regulations, at any time, and without notice.

- Videos are eligible for entry if produced and aired between the dates specified for that particular contest. For the purpose of any contest, “aired” means broadcast or cablecast, or shared with an audience of students, or presented to the community via closed-circuit or other playback device, or streamed on the internet.
- Previous entries from an earlier STN contest are not permitted, in whole, or as part of a current contest entry.
- The method of submission for an entry is particular to the contest being entered and is determined by STN on a contest by contest basis. Entry methods include, but are not limited to, USB flash drive and upload to the STN Upload System.
- Entries that have issues with playback or are not uploaded correctly will not be judged.
- Each entry costs \$20 and must be paid with a credit card at the time of registration. A receipt will be instantly emailed to you.
- Only affiliate advisers may access the STN Upload system for uploading entries. No students are permitted to use the system unless otherwise directed (under pandemic circumstances)
- Winning entries may be used by STN for marketing and promotional purposes.
- Contest entries are subject to United States Copyright Laws and may be disqualified by STN for disregarding these laws. Please refer to our [Use of Copyrighted Materials](#) document.
- All videos sent by contest participants become the property of STN. Winning entries may be compiled into a DVD for distribution by Student Television Network at its discretion. Schools agree to release rights to their winning entries for unlimited duplication and distribution, in any medium, worldwide, into perpetuity, without compensation. These rights may include uploading of the entries to partner/sponsor websites. No entries will be returned.

EXPECTATIONS FOR TIMED CONTESTS WITH PROMPTS

INTENT & SPIRIT

The intent of these contests is to mimic a real-life situation where a reporter team or film crew is given an assignment and a specific period of time to complete the assignment. The spirit of these contests is to present a level starting point for all to discover the true challenge of creative work under pressure.

WHAT YOU **MAY DO IN ADVANCE**

- Practice your pre-production... assign positions, prepare checklists, design a game plan.
- Research the geographic area... locally get to know your city and environment, so you know some good locations to shoot. Note landmarks, special sites, etc.
- For convention contests, review maps of the area and study some of the locations within the area of the convention hotel. Note landmarks, special sites, etc.
- Research the city history and background. Learn as much as you can about the convention city so your knowledge can be put to use when you get the prompt.
- Research the community leaders so you know key names.

WHAT YOU **MAY NOT DO IN ADVANCE**

- Identify or contact specific people to interview.
- Schedule interviews or reserve locations.
- Write any copy, plan a script, or storyboard in advance.
- Pre-shoot any audio or video footage.

WHAT THE **JUDGES LOOK FOR**

- Evidence of strong production skills despite the tight time constraints
- Creative interpretations of the prompt with strong supporting production elements
- Writing, scripting, and/or reporting that makes a clear connection to the prompt
- Audio and visuals that show an effort to reflect the theme of the prompt
