LIGHTCRAFT SPECIAL EFFECTS

It was a magical day in 2019 when we received a call from Academy Award Winner Bill Warner. Mr. Warner was developing a new, cutting edge technology called Lightcraft and he offered CHSTV an opportunity to test the system. With Lightcraft, scenes filmed on a green screen "come to life" using a special technology called Virtual Production.

Over the last four years we have produced hundreds of segments using the Lightcraft technology.

SECTION 4 CHSTV SPORTS LIVESTREAM SCORES BIG THIS YEAR!


ABOVE AND BEYOND

Our two announcers (Cash Versailles and Roy Kane) have added a level of professionalism and character to the broadcast and they have become fan favorites.

We have heard anecdotally that spectators have opted to watch the games at home because of the quality of our coverage this year.

With Instant Replay, a special sideline microphone system and a sideline camera system- our coverage is being compared to professional "ESPN level" broadcast quality.
