2026 STN FINAL INSTRUCTIONS
BE AT THE SAN DIEGO AIRPORT
FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 27TH AT 9:00AM

San Diego Airport Instructions: All Students and Chaperones are responsible for getting themselves to the Southwest Flight Terminal at San Diego Airport.

Students are allowed 1 carry one and 1 personal item.

Please escort your student to their travel chaperone and check-in with them.

Students that are 18 years old must have a California REAL ID or passport with them when going through security. All other students must bring their School ID.

Carry on sizes permitted is 24"(L)x16"(W)x10"(H) these dimensions include the wheels and handles. Be sure to measure your bag carefully. **Personal item is considered a purse, backpack or lap top bag.**

Liquids, aerosols, gels, creams and pastes- Each passenger is permitted to bring one quart-sized bag of liquids aerosols, gels, creams, and pastes in your carryon bag and through the TSA security checkpoint. These are limited to 3.4 ounces (100 milliliters) or less per item. During screening, you'll be required to place these items in the small bag separate from your carryon baggage unless you have been selected for TSA Pre Check expedited screening, in which case you may be exempt from removing your liquids during the screening process.

Any liquid, aerosol, gel, cream or paste that alarms during screening will require additional screening.

Make sure your student eats a good breakfast before arriving at the airport. They are also allowed to bring snacks for the plane. Much cheaper to pack them than purchase at the airport or on the plane. They will be able to purchase dinner once they arrive at the hotel in Tampa approx. 9:00-9:30 pm Florida time!! We also suggest that they bring an EMPTY water container- they will be able to fill it at the airport after going through security and then will be able to use it at the hotel.

LUGGAGE TAGS Luggage tags are REQUIRED on ALL suitcases, ALL backpacks, ALL camera bags, ETC.

PARENTS/STUDENTS/CHAPERONES: Be sure to **read ALL information in your packet** (downloaded from the CHSTV website) prior to your trip. Students should be familiar with where the forms are on their phones. They should also be aware of when and where their contest is and be familiar with the schedule of events. Each student will receive a call from his or her chaperones. Parents, please know your student's chaperones name and cell phone numbers. STUDENTS NEED TO PUT INTO THEIR CELL PHONES THEIR CHAPERONES PHONE NUMBERS. They are also required to share their location with their chaperones once they arrive at the airport. They may not turn it off until arriving back in SD.

WHAT TO PACK: In addition to the suggested packing list, please bring comfortable and appropriate clothes and walking shoes for the duration of STN and one dressy outfit for closing ceremonies. Please **DO NOT** wear your CHSTV/VMSTV shirts until instructed to at STN. Electronics (laptops, camera, and cell phones, with chargers) **must be labeled with both the students name and school.** CHSTV cannot be responsible for valuable items brought on the trip.

BRINGING HOMEWORK- It is expected that students will bring their homework. The best time to do this is on the plane.

CASH FOR THE CONVENTION: \$300.00 should be enough for the four days for the meals that won't be provided. You might want to bring a little extra money to purchase shirts etc. from the STN convention store. Saturday, Sunday, and Monday we will provide a continental breakfast. Saturday, Crazy 8 Day, we will also provide lunch. **Please talk to your student about budgeting** (money goes fast especially if they buy Starbuck's/Coffee Bean which we discourage.)

AIRPORT PICK UP: We will be returning to SAN DIEGO AIRPORT on Tuesday, March 3rd Southwest at 9:10pm
Please be prompt picking up your student!

Southwest Baggage Guidelines

You may carry on one bag and one personal item. The bag should be stowed in the overhead compartment, and your small personal item should be stowed under your seat.

Sizing up your carryon and personal item:

One carryon bag

- Goes in overhead bin
- Size limits: 24" (L) + 16" (W) + 10" (H). Wheels, handles, and attachments to your carryon will apply toward these dimensions.
- Examples: roller bag, small suitcase

One carryon personal item

- Goes under your seat
- Examples: purse (including crossbody bags), briefcase, laptop computer case, backpack, pillow (neck pillows do not count toward the carryon limit), blanket, small camera

Liquids in your carry on:

3.4 ounces or smaller sized containers that fit in 1 quart-sized, resealable bag may go in carry-on.

WHAT TO EXPECT IN THE SUPERVISED EDIT ROOM

- Supervised editing only applies to general contests, and not to Crazy 8's contests.
- Food is **NOT** allowed in the Supervised Edit Room. Students are allowed to bring in water in a closed-top container or bottle. If a student needs to bring in food due to a medical condition, accommodations will be made for them. Please contact shonda@studenttelevision.com to create an accommodation plan prior to the convention.
- Editors should use the restroom before entering the Edit Room. Breaks will be limited. Students will leave their badge and phone at the Contest Desk in order to re-enter.
- Editors must have their wristbands securely around their wrists before they will be allowed to enter the Edit Room. Students are **NOT** allowed to change wristbands once inside.
- The Supervised Edit Room is required for all general contests, unless otherwise specified on the [Contest Schedule](#). Editors must report no later than 15 minutes after their scheduled edit time. After 15 minutes, teams will receive a point deduction on their entry.
- With the exception of the Edit Only contests, we encourage recording and transferring any necessary audio, such as voiceovers, before entering the Edit Room to minimize unexpected background noise. Teams are responsible for bringing in their own recording devices, such as microphones and audio recorders. Teams will not be allowed to leave to record audio once they have entered the Edit Room. **Please plan accordingly!**
- All contest assets, including video, audio, and graphics **MAY** be loaded into a folder onto the teams computers before entering the Edit Room. However, the editing timeline must be clean when editors enter the Edit Room. A Contest Team Lead may disqualify an entry if there is any evidence of cheating. Their decision is final.
- Editing apps must be installed **PRIOR** to entering the Edit Room. We recommend all editing apps be used in offline mode so it operates without the internet. STN will only provide a low bandwidth Wifi to allow for Adobe authentication. Schools may use personal hotspots in the Edit Room or purchase an internet package through the Tampa Convention Center/SmartCity.
- There will be **NO** internet provided in the Supervised Edit Room. There will only be a restricted, low bandwidth internet access for students needing to authenticate Adobe apps.
- Advisers should have no communication with their students pertaining to the contests while in the Supervised Edit Room. If there is a technical issue, the editor should ask a Contest Team member for assistance to troubleshoot the problem. If it is determined a replacement is needed, the editor will be allowed to contact another team member and arrange for them to bring the replacement. A Contest Team member will supervise this process to ensure contest fairness and integrity. Advisers should not text students while they are editing, and advisers will not be allowed in the editing area.

Students will come to Upload Bay with a flash drive or SD card to connect using their password to upload their entry before the deadline. **Advisers should provide passwords to their students before they begin their contests. Passwords are listed on their Convention invoice. A link to access QR code tickets will be available in the Dashboard for self-printing or for students to**

take a picture of, allowing them to easily reference and scan the code at the upload kiosk. The deadline has been met once the entry is in the queue.

CONVENTION CONTEST GUIDELINES

- Review all necessary documents in the [shared 2026 Convention folder](#) prior to traveling to Tampa.
- Students must wear their convention badges at all times while filming around Tampa. The badge serves as their official authorization, recognized by Tampa Police, Parks and Recreation, and other local authorities.
- Drones **ARE NOT** allowed. Use of personal drone or any aerial footage in contest entries will result in disqualification. Only drone or aerial footage supplied by STN and/or the city of Tampa is permitted for use if provided as assets for a specific contest.
- Schools should not pre-book interviews before contest prompts are released, as this goes against the spirit of the competition. Additionally, schools should not ask businesses or individuals for exclusive interviews or discourage them from working with other schools. Any violations of these rules should report the issue to the Contest Desk.
- It is **STRONGLY** recommended to remain in groups when traveling in and around Tampa. Never travel alone and always communicate your whereabouts with your adviser and chaperones.
- All video footage used in the entry must have been recorded during the contest period. Shooting b-roll and scheduling or conducting interviews prior to starting is strictly prohibited. No previous contest, archival, or news wire footage can be used in convention contests. However, the use of personal still photography or video provided with explicit permission from the original owner is allowed, as long as it is cited in the video and is less than 10% of the total footage.
- Teams **MAY** use previously produced graphics, including opens, lower thirds, credits and other visual effects. Graphics can be from their regularly produced program, or created specifically for the 2026 Convention.
- Only copyright free music is allowed in contest entries. Due to limited Wi-Fi access, we recommend schools download all music they need for their contest entry prior to entering the Edit Room. Schools can use their own music library service and/or use music if provided by STN for a specific contest.
- All Edit Only contest assets required for the contests will be provided via a download link in the Edit Room. These contests include Tell the Story Editing, Sports Highlight Editing, Action Sports Editing, and Sports Promo Editing.
- When the entry is completed, teams will use a flash drive or SD card to upload at Upload Bay in the Edit Room using the unique password listed on their Convention invoice or by scanning the QR code. Advisers should provide passwords or QR code to their students before they begin their contests. A link to access QR code tickets will be available in the Dashboard for self-printing or for students to take a picture of, allowing them to easily reference and scan the code at the upload kiosk.
- Please allow enough time to export, finalize, and submit your entry to ensure a smooth submission process. Rushing the final steps can lead to unexpected technical issues, such as rendering errors or the need to compress your file size to 250 MB. Since late entries will not be accepted, we highly recommend giving yourself a buffer to avoid any last-minute complications.

The deadline has been met once a student carrying the flash drive or SD card with the final, exported entry is inside the queue area. No matter how long it takes at that point, the upload will happen. The deadline has been met. When a contest deadline passes, the queue will be cordoned off. Schools should send ONE student to the queue area in Upload Bay. Students


may not enter the Upload Bay area with a laptop, still exporting. Allow time to export to flash drive or SD card before you arrive to upload your entry.
